N4C Notes

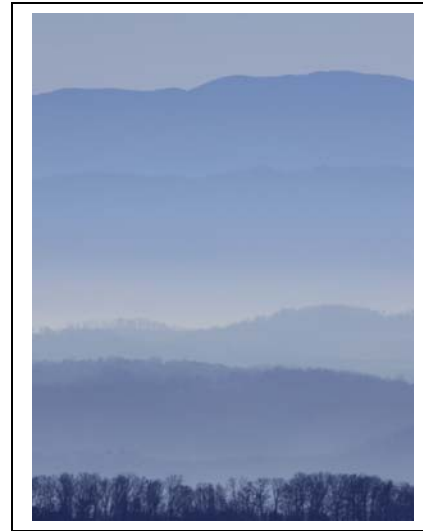

Tip of the Month - Memory Cards

From Marty DeWitt

Here are just a few thoughts to offer about your memory cards. Use several smaller capacity cards rather than one large capacity card. That way if a card goes bad, the "trauma" is limited. When changing cards, store the used cards face down in your card case so you can distinguish them from unused cards. If you know a shot is bad, delete it right away on the card. That will save you time at the computer. Lastly, make sure you completely re-format the card, but only after you have backed up your Images in at least two places.
